 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do
 hereby sell and quit claim to the said Solon
 O. Thatcher his heirs and assigns forever all
 their right and title in and to the following
 described tracts of lands to wit, The fractional
 South West Quarter of Section number seven
 in Township number Twelve in Range
 Number Twenty, and the North half of the
 North half of the North west fractional
 quarter of section number eighteen, Township
 and range aforesaid in the Delaware land
 in Kansas lying east of the Sixth principal
 Meridian, and in the County of Jefferson
 and State of Kansas retaining however
 to the said company and its assigns
 the rights of way for said Rail Road
 or for any Rail Road connecting therewith
 along and across said lands and also the
 right to take such gravel, earth stone and
 Water from said lands with the right of
 way thereto, as may be necessary in the
