

Sarcosie This Indenture and agreement
 To Dred made and entered into this
 Sidney Clark fourteenth day of July A.D.
 Reed, Aug 23^d 1862 eighteen hundred and sixty two
 at 9 O'clock A.M. (1862) between Sarcosie a Delaware
 S.C. Gephart Indian of Delaware Tribe residing
 Register of Deeds in the State of Kansas of the
 first part and Sidney Clark
 of the County of Douglas and State of Kansas
 of the second part, Witnesseth, That the said
 Sarcosie of the Delaware Tribe of Indians
 aforesaid for and in consideration of the
 sum of Four thousand five hundred Dollars
 in Gold coin of the United States to him
 in hand paid by the said Sidney Clark
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 has and by these presents doth grant bargain
 sell convey and confirm unto the said Sidney
 Clark of the second part and to his heirs
 and assigns or grantee forever, all of the
 right title interest and claim of him the
 said Sarcosie in and to the following
 described pieces and parcels of land, lying
 situate and being in the County of Jefferson
 and State of Kansas, and Patented to him
 the said Sarcosie, by the United States
 of America by letter Patent bearing date
 the Twenty fourth day of August A.D. one
 thousand eight hundred and sixty one and
 containing three hundred and five acres more
 or less, viz. The North West quarter of the North
 East quarter of fractional section number
 thirty (30) in township number twelve (12) of
 Range twenty (20) containing forty acres
 The South half of the North East quarter
 of fractional section number thirty (30) in
 Township number twelve (12) of Range twenty (20)
 containing eighty (80) acres and lots five (5) six (6)
