 of the first part and Sidney Clark
 of Douglas County Kansas party of
 the second part, Witnesseth that the
 said parties of the first part for and
 in consideration of the sum of Twelve
 hundred Dollars in gold coin of the
 United States to them in hand paid
 by the said party of the second part
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 have granted bargained sold and conveyed
 and by these presents do grant bargain
 sell and convey, release and confirm
 unto the said Sidney Clark party of
 the second part and to his heirs and
 assigns or grantors forever, all of their
 right title interest and claim, in and
 to the following described pieces and
 parcels of land lying and situated in
 the County of Jefferson and State of
 Kansas and containing Two hundred
 and ninety four acres to wit: The West
 fractional one half of fractional Section
 Number twenty nine (29) of Township number
 twelve of Range Number Twenty (20) said
 land having been Patented to the said
 parties of the first part by the United
