 land to Wit: Section number Twenty and
 the West half of Section Twenty one, and the
 East half of Section Nineteen in Township
 number Twelve in Range number Twenty of
 the Delaware Lands in Kansas lying east
 of the Sixth principal Meridian. In Witness
