This indenture made this twenty fifth day of June A.D. 1863 between Robert S. Stevens his wife and William A. Simpson all of Douglas County State of Kansas parties of the first part and Martha Robinson of town of Spencer State of Massachusetts party of the second part witnesseth that whereas Charles Robinson and the said Robert S. Stevens and William A. Simpson have been and are owners and tenants in common of the following land in Township Twelve South of Range Twenty East of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Kansas to wit: The West half of Section twenty nine lying North of the Kansas river and all of Section Thirty lying North and
