

and being all of fractional Section No Six, in Township No twelve, Range No twenty Rail Road lands, of the said Company, acquired from the Delaware Indians by Treaty. The said Leavenworth, Pawnee & Western Rail Road Company reserving to itself the right of way for said Rail Road or for any Rail Road connecting therewith, not exceeding one hundred feet along and across said lands, and also the right to take such gravel, earth Stone, and water, from said Lands, with the right of way thereto as may be necessary in the construction of said Rail Road. In testimony whereof the said Leavenworth, Pawnee & Western Rail Road Company, by Andrew J. Isaacs, their Vice President (who is duly authorized by the fifth Section of the by-laws of said Company to execute deeds in the absence of the President) have executed this deed and affixed thereto their corporate seal, with the attestation of Samuel Denman the Secretary of the said Company at Leavenworth City Kansas on this fifteenth day of May A.D. 1863.
