this day paid to the  
Union Pacific Railway  
Company C. & C., by Mary  
J. Whitney of Jefferson Co-  
unty State of Kansas, and in further con-  
sideration of Four certain Promissory Notes  
each for Nineteen <sup>27</sup> Dollars, this day executed  
by the said Mary J. Whitney in favor of  
the said Rail Road Company, and  
made payable in One Two Three and  
Four years respectively from this date  
and of one other note - mortgage for Two  
hundred and twenty-nine <sup>60</sup> dollars  
payable in five years, with interest thereon  
at the rate of Six per cent per annum  
payable annually, which notes fall due  
only on the completion of Twenty five miles  
of said Railroad from Leavenworth West-
