 Register of Deeds, and Susan B. Griswold of
 County of Douglas and State
 of Kansas of the second part, witnesseth that
 the said parties of the first part for and
 in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred
 Dollars (Dollars) to them in hand paid the
 receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have
 bargained sold and quit claimed and
 by these presents do bargain sell and
 quit claim unto the said party of the
 second part and to her heirs and
 assigns all that certain piece or parcel
 of Land lying in the County of Jefferson
 State of Kansas described as follows, To
