This Indenture
 Made this 3 day
 of August, in the
 year of our Lord
 one thousand eight
 hundred and sixty
 four between Charles
 F. Saurin and
 Mary Saurin, his
 wife of the township
 of Sarcoville in the County of Jefferson
 and State of Kansas, of the first
 part, and Elizabeth Bordell, of the town
 of Sarcoville, in the County of Jefferson
 and State of Kansas, of the second
 part: Witnesseth that the party of the
 first part in consideration of the sum
 of thirty five Dollars, to them duly paid
 have sold, and by these presents do
 grant and convey to the said party
 of the second part her heirs and
 assigns forever, all that tract or parcel
 of land, described as follows, to wit:
 Commencing two hundred and twenty
 eight feet South of the South East
 corner of the South East quarter of
 Section thirty in Township No twelve (12)
 of Range No twenty (20) thence South
 fifty five feet, thence west one hundred
 and thirty two feet thence South fifty
 five feet, thence East one hundred
 and thirty-two feet, to the place
 of beginning, with the appurtenances
 and all the estate, title and interest
 of the said party of the first part
 therein, And the said Charles F.
 Saurin and Mary Saurin, his
 wife do hereby covenant and
