 the 22<sup>nd</sup> of March 1864 of record in the  
 Office of Register of Deeds of Leavenworth  
 County Kansas which Lands are situate  
 in Township 10 Range 22 and Township 10  
 Range 21 in Leavenworth County Kansas  
 and also all other Lands now owned or  
 hereafter acquired by said Ewing in the  
 Tract sold by the Delaware Indians to the  
 Leavenworth Lawrence and Weston Rail  
 Road Company and to receive and  
 receipt for all Cash Notes or other  
 property given in payment for any of  
 said Lands and to make acknowledge  
 execute and deliver title bonds Special  
 Warranty deeds in general Warranty Deeds  
 to such purchasers for such Lands  
 in our names as Witness our hands  
 and seals at Leavenworth City Kansas  
 this twenty ninth day of March A. D. 1864.
