This Indenture
 made this fifteenth

 the year of our Lord
 one thousand eight
 hundred and sixty
 one between Sar-cay-ee
 chief of the Turtle
 band of the Delaware

Tribe of Indians and Ma-me-maw-o-ga-
 his wife of the Delaware Reserve, so called
 Situate in the State of Kansas of the first
 part and Charles Robinson, Robert S. Stevens
 & William A. Simpson of Douglas County State
 of Kansas of the second part. Witnesseth that
 the said parties of the first part, for and
 in consideration of the sum of Six Thousand
 four hundred dollars to them in hand
 paid by the said parties of the second
 part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 have granted bargained and sold and
 by these presents do grant bargain and
 sell unto the said parties of the second
 part their heirs and assigns all that
 certain piece or parcel of land Situated
 in Jefferson County State of Kansas, Known
 as Section No Thirty (30) in Township No Twelve (12)
 of Range No Twenty (20) East of the Sixth principal
 meridian, excepting the following to wit, The
 North East quarter of said Section Thirty
 as lies East of Kansas River, also further
 excepting so much of said Section thirty
 South or West of the Kansas River, The
 premises hereby conveyed being otherwise
 described as follows: So much of the South
 half of Section No Thirty in Township No
 Twelve of Range No Thirty as lies North
