Indian, which he has the right to locate upon
any Lands in Kansas Territory open to settlement
or pre-emption and which is unsettled or unclaimed
and which said Section the said Lykins agrees to
locate upon the said Town of Lawrence, and out of
which to secure by good Title to me such interest
