 these presents.

The condition of this obligation is such that
 if the said Robinson shall convey whatever title he
 may receive from the said lots from the Trustees
 of the Town Site of Lawrence to the said Hill or
 his assigns, then this obligation shall be of no effect or
 otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
