This Indenture made this second day of June
A.D. 1855 between Samuel F. Sawyer, Joel Soper, John P. Wood
William H. R. Lykins & George W. Hutchinson, Trustees
of the Townsite of Lawrence Kansas Territory, of the first
part, and Horatio N. Bent party of the second part
Witnesseth, that in compliance with the provisions
contained in the Deed in Trust from one William H. R.
Lykins to the above Trustees, creating said Trustees,
and in consideration of the sum of one dollar in hand paid
by said Horatio N. Bent of said Town and Territory, the
receipt whereof it hereby acknowledged, have conveyed
released and quit-claimed, and by these presents doth
convey release and quit-claim unto the said party of the
second part his heirs and assigns, all right title and
interest in and to certain lots of land situate and being
in Lawrence First Council District Kansas Territory
and designated on the Lithographed Chart as surveyed by
A. P. Seal October A.D. 1854 as follows - to wit -

Share number one hundred sixty five (165) containing
lots as follows - Massachusetts tract one hundred fourteen
(114) - Vermont tract eighty two (82) and one hundred (100) -
Louisiana tract one hundred forty eight (148) - Indiana tract
