 cutors, administrators and assigns forever, all my right, title,
 interest, claim and demand in and to the following described
 land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the
 Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by
 A. D. Seale, A.D. 1854, to wit: Vermont Street twenty one
 (21) - Massachusetts St 54, Ohio St 79. New York 15. N.Y.
 Street 157 - Conn 83 - Wf, St, 51 - Conn, 155, Connth 153 - La, St,
 295 Md St, 53 + 55 - - - - -

And if the said Azro Hazen as aforesaid, my heirs,
 executors, administrators and assigns, are held and firmly
 bound by these presents, in the sum of five hundred
 dollars to Forrest Savage aforesaid his heirs, executors,
 administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over
 and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall
 receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence,
 or from any power, or person or persons whatsoever to
 any and all of the above described property, to have and
 to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances
 therunto belonging forever.
