Now the Condition of this obligation is such, that if, upon the payment by the said party of the second part of all taxes lawfully assessed upon the aforesaid premises, the said parties of the first part or their successors, shall make and deliver unto the said party of the second part, his heirs or assigns, a good and valid Deed with the usual covenants for conveyance in fee simple, whenever a patent for the Town Site of Lawrence shall issue from Congress unto one Robert Robittail, or William H. R. Lykins, and be conveyed unto the aforesaid Trustee, then this obligation shall be ^{void and} of no effect, otherwise to remain in full force -
