D. Seal, A.D. 1854 to wit - Lot number one hundred and eighty one (181) and two hundred & twenty nine (229) Mississippi Street - One hundred & twenty six (226) Indiana Street, one hundred & forty five (145) Connecticut Street, one hundred & thirty five (135) New York Street -

And I, Jerome B. Taft aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars to Norman Allen aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power, or person or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property, to have and to hold the same, with all the privileges and appurtenances therunto belonging forever -
