I Now all Men by these Presents, That I, Andrew J. Whitney, of the Territory of Kansas, have made constituted and appointed, and by these presents do make constitute and appoint Carmel W. Babcock of Lawrence in the Territory aforesaid, my true and lawful Attorney, for me, and in my name, place and stead to sell and convey by quitclaim all my interest in and to two Shares in the Town of Lawrence numbered one hundred and eighty four (184) and one hundred and sixteen (116), giving and granting unto my said attorney, full power and authority, to do and perform all and every act and thing whatsoever, requisite and necessary to be done in and about the premises, as fully, and to all intents and purposes, as I might or could do if personally present, with full power of substitution and revocation, hereby ratifying and confirming all that my said attorney, or his substitute shall lawfully do, or cause to be done, by virtue thereof.
