 right, title, interest, claim and demands in and to the follow-
 ing described lands, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence
 in the Territory of Kansas according to the survey made
 by A. D. Seale, A. D. 1854. to wit:

Lot number sixty two (62) on Kentucky Street.

And if Thomas Burden aforesaid, my heirs,
 executors, administrators and assigns, are held and firmly
 bound by these presents, in the sum of Four Hundred
 Dollars, to Ezra H. Bush aforesaid, his heirs, exe-
 cutors, administrators and assigns, to well and truly make
 over and convey unto him or them all the title which
 I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of
 Lawrence, or from any power, or person or persons whom-
 soever, to any and all of the above described property,
 to have and to hold the same, with all the privileges
 and appurtenances thereto in anywise belonging forever.
