 bound by these presents, in the sum of Two Hundred
 Dollars to S. B. Prouty aforesaid, his heirs executors

 of Lawrence or from any power, or person or persons
 whomsoever, to any and all of the above described
 property, to have and to hold the same with all the
 privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, forever.
