

This Indenture made this second day of June A.D. 1855 between Samuel S. Snyder, Joel L. Over, John P. Wood, William H. R. Lykins and George W. Huntington, Trustees of the Town Site of Lawrence, Kansas Territory ^{parties} of the first part, and Erastus D. Ladd, party of the second part. Witnesseth that in compliance with the provisions contained in the Deed in Trust from one William H. R. Lykins to the above Trustees, creating said Trust, and in consideration of the sum of one dollar in hand paid by said Erastus D. Ladd of said Town and Territory, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have conveyed, released and quitclaimed, and by these presents do convey release and quitclaim unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all right, title and interest in and to certain lots of land situated and being in Lawrence, First Council District, Kansas Territory, and designated on the Lithographed Chart as surveyed by A. D. Israel October, A.D. 1854, as follows, to wit:—

To Have and to Hold the aforesaid quitclaimed premises with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said party of the second part, ^{his heirs and assigns} so that neither we, said Trustees, our heirs or successors, or any person claiming to, from or under us or them, shall have any right,
