 receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained sold and
 quitclaimed, and by these presents do bargain sell and quitclaim
 unto the said Chas. F. Thompson, his heirs executors, adminis-
 trators & assigns, forever, all my right title interest claim and
 demand in and to the following described land, situate and
 lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas,
 according to the survey made by A. D. Carl. AD 1854. Cont'd:-

Lot No (33) Thirty Three in Connecticut Street.

And I, C.W. Smith aforesaid, my heirs, executors,
 administrators & assigns, am held and firmly bound by
 these presents in the sum of Thirty Dollars to said Chas.
 F. Thompson aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators
 & assigns, to will and truly make over and convey unto
 him or them any further all the title which I shall receive
 from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence or from
 any power, or person or persons whosoever, to any and all of the
 above described property. To have and to hold the same with
 all the privileges & appurtenances thereto belonging, forever.
