

Know all Men by these Presents that I, John Doy of the Town of Lawrence, Territory of Kansas, for and in consideration of the sum of Forty Dollars to me in hand paid by John Dodsworth of the aforesaid Town and Territory, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, and quit-claimed and by these presents do bargain, sell, and quit claim unto the said John Dodsworth, his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest, claim, and demand in and to the following described land situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas according to the survey made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to wit:

Known as Lot seventy seven New Hampshire Street

And the said John Doy aforesaid his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Forty Dollars to John Dodsworth of Town and Territory aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which he shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power, or person, or persons whomsoever to any and all of the above described property, to have and to hold the same, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging forever.
