And the said Carmi W. Babcock aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of One Thousand Dollars, to be paid to Sylvester B. Prentiss, aforesaid his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which he shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power, or person, or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property - To Have and to Hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging forever.
