

To have and to hold the aforesaid lot with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said Hill his heirs and assigns forever.

And further be it known by these presents that I the said John P. Wood am held and firmly bound unto the said Hill his heirs and assigns, in the sum of four hundred dollars to be paid unto the said Hill his heirs or assigns, to which payment I bind myself, my heirs and assigns firmly by these presents.

Now the condition of this obligation is such that if I the said Wood convey unto the said Hill whatever title may be to me conveyed by the Trustees of the Town Site of Lawrence, at such time as I may receive such title, then this obligation shall be wholly void and of no effect, otherwise to remain in full force.
