This Indenture made this second day of June A. D. 1855, between Samuel S. Snyder, Joel Grover, John P. Wood, William H. R. Lykins, and George W. Hutchinson, Trustees of the Town Site of Lawrence, Kansas Territory, of the first part, and Horatio N. Bent, party of the second part, Witnesseth that in compliance with the provisions contained in the Deed in Trust from one William H. R. Lykins to the above Trustees, creating said Trustees, and in consideration of the sum of one dollar in hand paid by said Horatio N. Bent of said Town and Territory, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. Have conveyed, released, and quit-claimed, and by these presents do convey release, and quit-claim unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, all right, title, and interest in and to certain lots of Land situate and being in Lawrence, First Council District, Kansas Territory and designated on the Lithographed Chart as surveyed by A. D. Searl, October A. D. 1854, as follows, to wit

Share number one hundred sixty five (165) containing lots as follows: -

Massachusetts street one hundred fourteen (114)
Vermont street eighty two (82) and one hundred (100)
Louisiana street one hundred forty eight (148) - Indiana street
