

This Indenture made this second day
of June A. D. 1855, between Samuel S. Snyder,
Joel Grover, John P. Wood, William H. R. Lykins,
and George W. Hutchinson, Trustees of the Town
Site of Lawrence, Kansas Territory parties of the
first part, and Francis Killam party of the
second part.

Witnesseth, that in compliance with the provisions
contained in the Deed of Trust from one William
H. R. Lykins to the above Trustees, creating said
Trustees, and in consideration of the sum of one
dollar in hand paid by said Francis Killam
of said Town and Territory, the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged, have conveyed, released
and quit-claimed and by these presents do convey,
release, and quit-claim unto the said party
of the second part his heirs and assigns,
all right, title, and interest, in and to certain
lots of Land situated and being in Lawrence,
First Council District, Kansas Territory, and
designated upon the Lithographed Chart as
surveyed by A. D. Learl, October A. D. 1854, as
follows: - To wit: -

Share number one hundred seventy nine
(179) containing lots as follows, Ohio street
twenty three (23) - Vermont street seventy two
(72) Ohio street eighty six (86) - N. York street
one hundred sixteen (116) - Rhode Island
street seventy (70) - Connecticut street one
hundred four (104) - Mississippi street one
hundred thirty three (133) - N. Jersey street
twenty (20) - Ohio street one hundred
seventy (70) and one hundred seventy two
(172) - Delaware street eleven (11) - and
lot N. Hampshire street twenty three (23)

To Have and to Hold the aforesaid
quit claimed premises with all the
privileges and appurtenances thereunto
belonging, unto the said party of the
second part, so that neither we said Trustees, our
heirs or successors, or any person claiming
by, from, or under us, shall
