Twelve on Vermont street and
eighty six on Massachusetts street in
the city of Lawrence, Kansas Territory,
as per Lawrence City map,

together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments, and appurtenances thereunto belonging, and the reversions, remainders, rents, issues, and profits thereof, and all the estate, title, and interest of the said John and Jane Doy to the premises
