

This Indenture made this second day of June A.D. 1855, between Samuel S. Snyder, Joel Grover, John P. Wood, William H. R. Lykins, and George W. Hutchinson, Trustees of the Town Site of Lawrence, Kansas Territory, parties of the first part, and John F. Ayer party of the second part,

Witnesseth that in compliance with the provisions contained in the Deed in Trust from one William H. R. Lykins to the above Trustees creating said Trustees, and in consideration of the sum of one dollar in hand paid by said John F. Ayer of said Town and Territory, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have conveyed, released, and quit-claimed, and by these presents do convey, release, and quit-claim unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns all right, title and interest in and to certain lots of land, situated and being in Lawrence, First Council District, Kansas Territory and designated on the Lithographed Chart as surveyed by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, as follows, to wit

Share number fifteen (15) containing lots as follows - N. Hampshire Street twelve (12) Rhode Island Street one hundred four (104) Connecticut Street ninety (90) and ninety two (92) - Ohio Street two hundred seventeen (217) and two hundred nineteen (219) - Illinois Street one hundred seventy six (176) - Pennsylvania Street one hundred twenty three (123) and one hundred twenty five (125) - N. York street one hundred eighty one (181) - Maryland Street forty nine (49)

To have and to Hold the aforesaid quit-claimed premises with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said party of the second part so that neither we said Trustees our heirs or successors, or any person, claiming by, from or under us or them, shall have any right, title, interest, claim, or demand in or to the aforesaid premises or any part thereof, and we
