Witnesseth that in compliance with the provisions contained in the Deed in Trust from one William H. R. Lykins to the above Trustees creating said Trustees and in consideration of the sum of one dollar in hand paid by said Cyrus K. Holliday of said Town and Territory, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have conveyed, released, and quit-claimed and by these presents do convey, release, and quit-claim unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all right, title, and interest in and to certain lots of land situated and being in Lawrence, First Council District, Kansas Territory, and designated on the Lithographed Chart as surveyed by A. D. Searl, October A.D. 1854, as follows, to wit:-
