edged, have bargained, sold, and quit-claimed, and
by these presents do bargain, sell, and quit-claim
unto the said Franklin Conant, his heirs, executors,
administrators, and assigns, forever, all my right,
title, interest, claim, and demand in and to the
following described land, situate and lying in the
Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas,
according to the survey made by A. D. Searl,
A. D. 1854, to wit:
