

Know all Men by these Presents. That I, Thomas Brooke of Lawrence, Kansas Territory, for and in consideration of the sum of eighty dollars, to me in hand paid by Sylvester B. Prentiss, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, conveyed, and quit-claimed, and by these presents bargain, sell, convey, and quit-claim unto the said Prentiss, his heirs and assigns, all my right, title, interest and claim to and in a certain lot of land situate in the Town and Territory aforesaid, and designated on the Lithographed Chart as surveyed by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, as follows, to wit. —

Lot Number twenty three Vermont street
To Have and to hold the aforesaid lot of land unto the said Prentiss his heirs and assigns to his and their sole use forever.

And be it further known that I am held and bound unto the said Prentiss his heirs and assigns in the sum of two hundred dollars, to be paid unto the said Prentiss his heirs and assigns to which payment well and truly to be made, I bind myself, my heirs and assigns firmly by these Presents.

Now the condition of this obligation is such that if upon the conveyance of any further title to said lot to me, by or from the Trustees of the Town Site of Lawrence, said Territory, or by or from any person or persons whatsoever, I the said Brooke make and convey such title unto the said Prentiss his heirs or assigns, then this obligation shall be wholly void and of no effect, otherwise to remain in full force.
