

Know all Men by these Presents, That I, Agro Hagen of Hartford, State of Vermont for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Forrest Savage of Lawrence, Kansas Territory, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, and quit-claimed, and by these presents do bargain, sell, and quit-claim unto the said Forrest Savage, his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest, claim, and demand in and to the following described land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to wit:-

Vermont Street twenty one (21). Massachusetts St. 54, Ohio St. 79, N. York 15, Ky. Street 157 - Con. 83 - N. J. St. 51 - Con. 155 - Con. St. 153 - La. St. 295, Md. St. 53 & 55

And I the said Agro Hagen as aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these presents, in the sum of five hundred dollars to Forrest Savage, aforesaid his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence or from any power, or person or persons whomsoever to any and all of the above described property.

To Have and to Hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging forever.
