

This Indenture made this second day of June A.D. 1855 between Samuel S. Snyder, Joel Grover, John P. Wood, William H. R. Lykins, and George W. Hutchinson, Trustees of the Town Site of Lawrence, Kansas Territory, parties of the first part, and Daniel Lowe party of the second part,

Witnesseth, that in compliance with the provisions contained in the Deed in Trust from one William H. R. Lykins, to the above Trustees, creating said Trustees, and in consideration of the sum of one dollar in hand paid by said Daniel Lowe of said Town and Territory, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have conveyed, released, and quit-claimed, and by these presents do convey, release, and quit-claim unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all right, title, and interest in and to certain lots of land situated and being in Lawrence, First Council District, Kansas Territory and designated on the Lithographed Chart as surveyed by A.D. Searl, October A.D. 1854, as follows, to wit

Share number twenty four (24) containing lots as follows:- N. Hampshire Street forty one (41). Vermont Street ninety nine (99). Tennessee Street one hundred fifty seven (157). Massachusetts Street one hundred seventy eight (178). Connecticut Street thirty nine (39). Delaware Street fifty nine (59). N. York Street one hundred fifty six (156) and one hundred fifty eight (158). Mississippi Street two hundred seventy six (276). Maryland Street one hundred thirty three (133) and one hundred thirty five (135) and lot Vermont Street two (2)

To have and to hold the aforesaid quit-claimed premises with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said party of the second part, so that neither we said Trustees, our heirs or successors, or any person claiming by, from or under us or them, shall have any
