D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to wit: -

Lots numbered two hundred forty two (242) two hundred forty four (244) and two hundred forty six (246) on Mississippi Street

And I, Samuel C. Wemple aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Five Hundred dollars, to be paid to Edwin Bond aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power, or person, or persons, whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property, to Have and to Hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging forever.
