And I, Samuel C. Wemple aforesaid,
 my heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns,
 are held and firmly bound by these presents

 executors, administrators, and assigns, to well
 and truly make over and convey unto him
 or them all the title which I shall receive
 from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence,
 or from any power, or person, or persons,

 the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging,
