Crutchfield, his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to wit:—

and the tenement and all appurtenances belonging thereunto.

And I, Daniel W. Palmer of Lawrence aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these presents, in the sum of Six Hundred Dollars to Wm. Crutchfield, aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power, or person, or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property, to have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging forever.
