

Know all Men by these Presents, That I, Jerome B. Taft, of the Town of Lawrence, Territory of Kansas, for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty five dollars, to me in hand paid by Norman Allen of the Town of Lawrence, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, and quit-claimed, and by these presents do bargain, sell, and quit-claim unto the said Norman Allen, his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand, in and to the following described land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory ^{of Kansas}, according to the survey made by A. D. Seard, A. D. 1854, to wit: -

Lots number one hundred and eighty one (181) and two hundred and twenty nine (229) Mississippi Street - two hundred & twenty six (226) Indiana Street, one hundred & forty five (145) Connecticut street, one hundred & thirty five (135) New York street

And I, Jerome B. Taft aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these presents, in the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars, to Norman Allen aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power, or person, or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property, to Have and to Hold the same, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging forever.
