

This Indenture made this second day of June A. D. 1855, between Samuel S. Snyder, Joel Grover, John P. Wood, William H. R. Lykins and George W. Hutchinson, Trustees of the Town Site of Lawrence, Kansas Territory, parties of the first part, and Henry W. Fick party of the second part.

Witnesseth, that in compliance with the provisions contained in the Deed in Trust from one William H. R. Lykins to the above Trustees, creating said Trustees, and in consideration of the sum of one dollar in hand paid by said Henry W. Fick, of said Town and Territory, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have conveyed, released, and quit claimed, and by these presents do convey, release, and quit claim unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, all right, title, and interest in and to certain lots of land situated and being in Lawrence, First Council District, Kansas Territory, and designated on the Lithographed Chart as surveyed by A. D. Searl, October A. D. 1854, as follows, to wit:-

Share number one hundred ninety one (191) containing Louisiana Street seventy five (75) - Kentucky Street sixty three (63) - Indiana Street one hundred fifty four (154) - N. York Street ninety (90) Rhode Island Street thirty eight (38) N. York street one hundred nine (109) Pinkney Street forty one (41) - N. Jersey Street eleven (11) Tennessee Street one hundred forty (140) and one hundred forty two (142) - Mississippi Street two hundred thirty one (231) and lot Massachusetts Street forty three (43)

To have and to hold the aforesaid quit-claimed premises with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said party of the second part, so that neither we said Trustees, our heirs, successors, or any person claiming by, from, or under us, or them shall have
