

This Indenture made this second day of June, A.D. 1855, between Samuel S. Snyder, Joel Grover, John P. Wood, William H. R. Lykins and George W. Hutchinson, Trustees of the Town Site of Lawrence, Kansas Territory, parties of the first part, and George L. Osborn party of the second part,

Witnesseth, that in compliance with the provisions contained in the Deed in Trust from one William H. R. Lykins to the above Trustees, creating said Trustees, and in consideration of the sum of one dollar in hand paid by said George L. Osborn, of said Town and Territory, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have conveyed, released, and quit claimed, and by these presents do convey, release, and quit claim unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all right, title, and interest in and to certain lots of land, situated and being in Lawrence, First Council District, Kansas Territory, and designated on the Lithographed Chart, as surveyed by A. D. Searl, October A.D. 1854, as follows, to wit:-

Share number four (4) containing lots as follows:- Levee two (2)- Vermont Street one hundred thirteen (113)- Kentucky Street one hundred forty one (141)- Rhode Island Street one hundred twenty eight (128)- Connecticut Street one hundred sixteen (116)- Delaware Street seventy (70)- Tennessee Street two hundred fifteen (215)- Illinois Street one hundred ninety eight (198)- Pennsylvania Street thirty six (36)- N. Jersey Street one hundred forty seven (147)- Indiana Street one hundred twenty three (123)- and lot Kentucky Street twenty eight (28)

To have and to hold the aforesaid quit-claimed premises with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said party of the second part, so that neither we, said Trustees, our heirs or successors, or any person claiming by, from, or under us or them, shall have any right, title, interest, claim, or demand in or to the aforesaid premises or any part thereof; and we hereby covenant and
