

This Indenture made this second day of June A.D. 1855 between Samuel S. Snyder, Joel Grover, John P. Wood, William H. R. Lykins, and George W. Hutchinson, Trustees of the Town Site of Lawrence, Kansas Territory, parties of the first part, and John Hutchinson party of the second part,

Witnesseth, that in compliance with the provisions contained in the Deed in Trust from one William H. R. Lykins, to the above Trustees, creating said Trustees and in consideration of the sum of one dollar in hand paid by John Hutchinson, of said Town and Territory, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have conveyed, released, and quit claimed, and by these presents do convey, release, and quit claim unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all right, title, and interest in and to certain lots of land situated and being in Lawrence, First Council District, Kansas Territory, and designated on the Lithographed Chart as surveyed by A.D. Searl, A.D. 1854, as follows, to wit: -

Lots number sixty eight (68) Ohio Street, one hundred fifty two (152) Kentucky Street, one hundred two (102) New Hampshire Street, Indiana Street three hundred twenty and three hundred twenty four (320) + (324), ninety six (96) New Jersey Street, one hundred fourteen (14) New Jersey Street, one hundred ninety five (195) Ohio Street, two hundred seventy three (273) and two hundred seventy five (275), Mississippi Street, one hundred fifty eight (158), New Jersey Street, thirty three (33), Rhode Island Street thirty four (34), Rhode Island Street twenty eight (28), Massachusetts Street seven (7),

New Hampshire Street, and lot thirty four (34) New Hampshire Street — To have and to hold the aforesaid, quit claimed premises with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said party of the second part, so that neither we, said Trustees, our heirs or successors, or any person claiming by, from, or under us or them, shall have any right, title, interest, claim or demand in or to the
