

Know all Men by these Presents, That I, James Jameson of the Town of Lawrence, Territory of Kansas, for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred + 25 dollars to me in hand paid by Margaret Jones, of the Town and Territory aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, and quit claimed, and by these presents do bargain, sell, and quit claim unto the said Margaret Jones, her heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Searl, A.D. 1854, to wit:-

Lot number sixty Vermont Street

And I, James Jameson aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents, in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars to Margaret Jones, aforesaid, her heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto her or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power, or person, or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property; to Have and to Hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging forever.
