

This Indenture made this Second day of June A.D. 1855, between Samuel S. Snyder, Joel Grover, John P. Wood, William H. R. Lykins and George W. Hutchinson, Trustees of the Town Site of Lawrence, Kansas Territory, parties of the first part, and Edward E. Ropes, party of the second part.

Witnesseth, that in compliance with the provisions contained in the Deed in Trust from one William H. R. Lykins to the above Trustees, creating said Trustees, and in consideration of the sum of one dollar in hand paid by said Edward E. Ropes of said Town and Territory, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have conveyed, released, and quit claimed, and by these presents do convey, release, and quit claim unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all right, title, and interest in and to certain lots of land situated and being in Lawrence, First Council District, Kansas Territory, as designated on the Lithographed Chart as surveyed by A. D. Searl, October, A. D. 1854, as follows, to wit:-

Share number two hundred six (206) containing lots as follows:- Vermont Street forty nine (49). Kentucky Street fifty six (56). Louisiana Street fifty (50). Tennessee Street one hundred eighteen (118). N. York Street twenty three (23) and seventy five (75) and seventy seven (77). Illinois Street two hundred fourteen (214) and two hundred sixteen (216). Pennsylvania Street twenty three (23). Mississippi Street one hundred fifty eight (158). and lot Connecticut Street fifteen (15)

To Have and to Hold the aforesaid, quit claimed premises with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said party of the second part, so that neither we said Trustees, our heirs or successors, or any person claiming by, from, or under us or them, shall have any right, title, interest,
