

Know all Men by these Presents, That I, Susan Bassett, of the Township of Douglass, Territory of Kansas, for and in consideration of the sum of fifteen dollars to me in hand paid by Jackson Means of the Town of Pleasant View, Shelby County, Indiana, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, and quit claimed and by these Presents do bargain, sell, and quit claim unto the said Jackson Means, his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest, claim, and demand, in and to the following described land situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to wit: -

And I, the said Susan Bassett aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of fifty dollars, to Jackson Means aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power, or person or persons whomsoever to any and all of the above described property, to Have and to Hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging forever.
