P. Taft, their heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand, in and to the following described land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to wit: -

Lot number thirteen (13) Pinkney Street

And I, Owen T. Bassett aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns are held and firmly bound, by these Presents, in the sum of Two Hundred Dollars, to John Haws and Wm. P. Taft aforesaid, their heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power or person, or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property, to Have and to Hold the same, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging forever.
