Taft of Kansas and Cleveland, Ohio, the receipt whereof, is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, and quit claimed and by these presents, do bargain, sell, and quit claim unto the said John Haws and Wm. P. Taft, their heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to wit:-

Lot number forty one (41) New Hampshire Street and Lot one hundred and fifty seven (157) Tennessee St.

And I, Daniel Lowe aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these presents, in the sum of Three Hundred Dollars to John Haws and William P. Taft aforesaid, their heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power, or person or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property, to Have and to Hold the same, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging forever.
