 made by A. D. Searl A.D. 1854 to wit: Lots number fifty five  
 Vermont st: seventy four (74) and seventy six Tennessee st:

 one hundred and eighty five (185) Ohio st: thirty one  
 Park: forty two and fifty two Connecticut st, one hundred  
 and eighty three (183) Indiana st: two hundred and fifty  
 four (254) and two hundred and ninety seven (297) Mississi-  
 pi st: fifty seven and one hundred and seventy two (72)  
 New York st: thirty nine New Jersey st. one hundred and

 privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging forever.
