Thompson his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever all my right title interest claim and demand in and to the following described land situate and lying in the town of Lawrence, in the territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Searl A. D. 1854 to wit: Lots no eighty (80) and eighty two (82) and forty two (42) and fifty two (52) Connecticut street.

And I, William D. Atwood aforesaid my heirs executors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars to C. F. Thompson aforesaid his heirs executors administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the trustees of the said town of Lawrence, or from any power or person or persons whomsoever to any and all of the above described property, to Have and to hold the same, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging.
