D. Seale A. D. 1854 to wit:

Lot number Seventy (70) New Hampshire street.

And I, Susan Bassett aforesaid my heirs executors administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these presents, in the sum of One Hundred Dollars, to Edward Sutton Smyth aforesaid, his heirs executors administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey to him or them all the title which I shall receive from the trustees of the said town of Lawrence, or from any power or person or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property. to Have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging forever.
