D. Searl A. D. 1854, to wit:

No thirty three (33) Rhode Island street.

And Charles W. Henley aforesaid my heirs executors administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of one hundred dollars, to G. W. Collamore aforesaid his heirs executors administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the trustees of the said town of Lawrence or from any power or person or persons whomsoever to any and all of the above described property: To Have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging forever.
